

Notice of Data Security Incident
July 30, 2026

Carient Heart and Vascular LLC (“Carient”) is providing notification of a recent data security incident. This notice includes information about the incident, our response, and steps potentially impacted parties may take to protect against possible misuse of their information, should they feel it necessary to do so.

What Happened? On June 24, 2026, Carient became aware of suspicious activity related to its network. Upon discovery, Carient immediately took steps to secure the environment and engaged a third-party forensic firm to investigate the incident. As a result, Carient learned that certain files were accessed by an unauthorized third party. Carient is conducting a diligent review of the files to identify whether they contained personal information or protected health information and, if so, what information was included and to whom that information relates. The investigation is currently ongoing.

What Information Was Involved?

Carient has determined the information impacted may include individuals’ first and last names in combination with one or more of the following data elements: date of birth, government-issued ID, financial account information and/or payment card information, medical information, and health insurance information.
